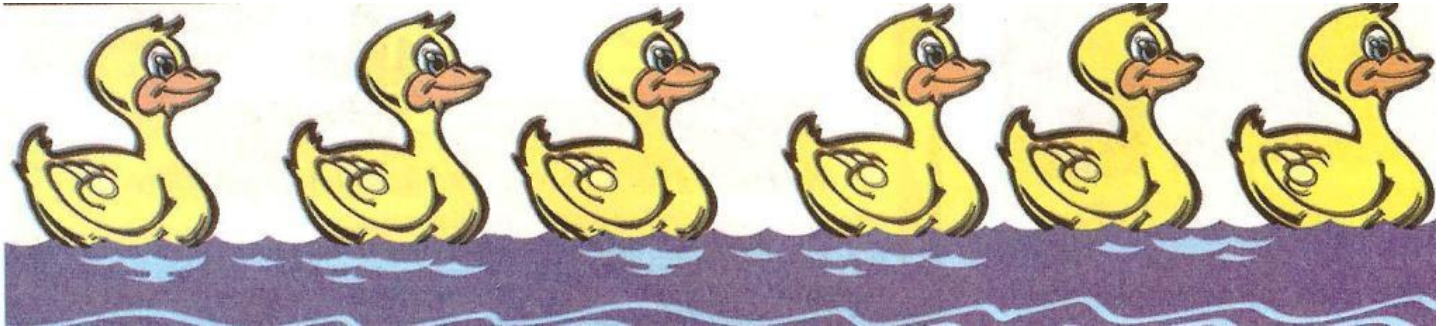


NOVICE GENEALOGY

- ✓ Place of birth, i.e. town, county, state/country
- ✓ Christening/Baptism date
- ✓ Place of Christening/Baptism
- ✓ Marriage date
- ✓ Place of marriage
- ✓ Divorce?
- ✓ Death Date
- ✓ Place of death
- ✓ Place of burial
- ✓ Place where this family lived.
